Your garden for wildlife can contribute to bringing nature home by welcoming wildlife to share your garden and by providing a healthy, weed free environment for them. Establishing more native plants and other habitat in the garden is not only valuable in itself, it can also link to habitat nearby, providing safe corridors or 'stepping stones' along which animals can move from place to place.

By becoming a 'Gardens for Wildlife' member and displaying the sign, you clearly demonstrate your support and commitment to protecting wildlife species and habitat.

If you would like to become a member of Barung Landcare's 'Gardens for Wildlife', please fill in the application form below. There is a **one off joining fee of \$30** (\$25 for Barung Landcare members) to cover costs of the program. Payment can be made via credit card or Paypal.

The 'Gardens for Wildlife' member's package includes a sign for your front entrance, information sheets, and invitation to workshops/field days demonstrating how to develop wildlife friendly gardens. You will also receive 10 wildlife friendly plants to be collected from Barung's Porter's Lane nursery. The first 150 members to sign up will receive 10 free tree guards and free entrance to workshops, until mid-2015.
